Mr. Dominic J. Maturo, 95, resident of Alachua, Florida, died Monday, January 9, 2012 in the E. T. York Hospice Care Center, following a long illness.

Mr. Maturo was a native of Hamden, Connecticut, son of the late Peter and Teresa DiCello Maturo. He was a [veteran](#) of [World War II](#), a recipient of a [purple heart](#) from being injured while serving in Germany in the U. S. [Army](#). After the war, Mr. Maturo returned to Connecticut where he began a career as a builder. He built custom homes and commercial buildings, including portions of Yale University. Mr. Maturo was a master gardener; a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church and was recently preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Francesca Maturo.

Survivors include; two daughters, Frances Maturo, of Alachua, and Anna Rose Maturo, of Gainesville; two sons, Michael Thomas Maturo of Alachua and Christopher Maturo; one sister, Nancy Maturo, of Connecticut; one granddaughter, Sarah Rebecca Parr, of San Diego.

A Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at 10:00 A. M., at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, with Father Roland Julien, celebrant.
